The season structure listed below should be considered tentative. All fisheries are subject to change inseason based on catch rates, run size and other unforeseen circumstances.

Summer salmon fisheries (proposed)

- Summer Chinook retention is closed both downstream and upstream of Priest Rapids Dam.
- Sockeye
 - Mainstem waters downstream of the Hwy. 395 Bridge at Pasco:
 - Open June 22 through July 6 with a one sockeye daily limit (one hatchery steelhead may also be retained within the daily bag limit).
 - Mainstem waters at and upstream of Hanford Reach and Priest Rapids Dam:
 - Open with different dates and a four sockeye daily limit.

Fall salmon fisheries (proposed)

- Buoy 10 upstream to west Puget Island:
 - Open Aug. 1 through Dec. 31.
 - Chinook retention is allowed Aug. 1 through Sept. 6 with hatchery Chinook only allowed Aug. 7-25.
 - The daily adult limit is two salmon, and when Chinook retention is allowed no more than one Chinook; release wild coho.
- West Puget Island upstream to the Lewis River:
 - o Open Aug. 1 through Sept. 6 and Oct. 1 through Dec. 31.
 - Chinook retention is allowed Aug. 1 through Sept. 6.
 - The daily adult limit is two salmon, and when Chinook retention is allowed no more than one Chinook; release wild coho.
- Lewis River upstream to Bonneville Dam & Bonneville Dam upstream to Hwy. 395 Bridge at Pasco:
 - o Open Aug. 1 through Sept. 17 and Oct. 1 through Dec. 31.
 - Chinook retention is allowed Aug. 1 through Sept. 17.
 - The daily adult limit is two salmon, and when Chinook retention is allowed no more than one Chinook; release wild coho downstream of Hood River Bridge.

Steelhead (proposed)

Summer steelhead daily limit is one hatchery fish when open as part of the adult limit, as described below.
